

In Bible times, doves were powerful messengers, especially during wartimes, and often brought good news. Will you be willing to share the good news as it says in Acts 1:8?

YOU WILL NEED:

- White Paper
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Black Marker
- Glue Stick
- Scissors

DIRECTIONS:



1. Fold a sheet of white paper in half.



2. Draw the shape of a dove as shown. Use a ruler to draw evenly spaced lines along the fold. Cut around the dove, and cut along the lines.



3. Open out the paper.



4. Glue the head of the dove together.



5. Turn the top portion of the other end of the dove inside out. Glue together.



6. Bring the end forward toward the dove's chest.



7. Slide the end into the dove's chest underneath.



8. Glue it together.



9. Draw on the eyes of the dove.



10. The devoted dove is ready!
