

Frogs sit on the bank of the pond, resting in God's sunshine. As children of God, we can bank on His goodness as stated in Psalm 103:2-5. God's promises make me LEAP for joy!

## YOU WILL NEED:

- Green Felt
- Red Felt
- Ruler

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut around one green bottle 2" from the bottom to make a cup for the head, and the other head, and the other
bottle $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom to make the body.

2. Glue the eyes to the bottle caps and hot-glue them together side by side. Glue them to the top of the head.


- Black Marker
- 2 Green Plastic Bottles
- Scissors
- 2 Green Plastic Lids
- Utility Knife 《 $\downarrow$
- 2 Large Googly Eyes
- Hot Glue Gun (b)


3. Cut out 4 squares of green felt, $4 \times 4$ " . Cut a coin slot in the middle of each. Glue 2 squares together, lining up the slots. Repeat for the other 2 squares.

4. Glue the short strips to the front of the body at the top. Attach the hands.

5. From the green plastic, cut 6 toes ( $2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ), 2 plastic strips ( $5 \times 1 \frac{11 / 2 ") \text { ), }}{}$ 2 smaller plastic strips ( $2^{1122^{\prime \prime}} \times \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ), and 2 hands with 4 fingers ( $1 \times 1$ ").

6. Glue 3 toes together in a fan shape. Glue both ends of one long green strip to the side of the body at the of the body at the
bottom. Glue the feet on. Repeat for the other side.


7. Cut out the tongue from red felt ( $3 \times 1^{\prime \prime}$ ) and glue it to the body inside the mouth.

8. Glue a small strip of green felt at the back to join the head to the body.
9. Glue the felt squares over the top of the bottle cups that you cut out. Let dry. Trim off excess felt.
10. The frog is ready! Now you can save up coins for church or to help a friend.
