

Jacob needed to show equal love between his sons, like it says in 1 Peter 2:17. With this craft, remember to respect and love everyone!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Large Empty Plastic Container with a Handle and Lid
- Colored Permanent Markers
- Paint
- Sponge
- Awl
- Hot Glue Gun
- Craft Knife



DIRECTIONS:



1. Draw a circle around the neck of the lid that is 1/4" larger than the neck.



5. Cut off any plastic sticking out of the lid.



9. Use an awl to poke several holes in the lid of the container.



2. Carefully cut out along the line, cutting out the neck with the lid.



6. Cut off a little from the neck of the container so that the lid can be screwed on more lightly.



10. Screw the lid onto the neck. If the lid does not fit snugly on the surface of the container, use

hot glue when you fasten it.



3. Unscrew the lid from the neck of the container.



7. Place the neck of the container on the side of the container a little lower from the top. Trace around the inner circle with a marker.



11. Peel off any stickers or labels from the container. If necessary. paint the surface after removing the stickers.



4. If there is an extra plastic part on the neck of the container, remove it.



8. Cut out the circle with a knife. Insert the neck of the container into the hole from the inside to the outside.



12. Write the phrase: **LET KINDNESS GROW** on the watering can. Decorate to your taste. Your homemade watering can will help you to water
