



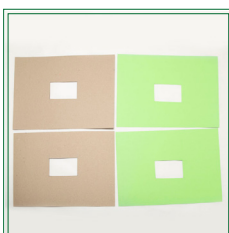

### YOU WILL NEED:

- 3 Green Cardstock (8½" x 11")
- 1 Sheet of Paper (8½" x 11")
- 3 Poster Board (8½" x 11")
- 2 Zippers (7")
- Craft Knife
- Masking Tape
- Cord
- Sticky Glue
- Scissors
- Fabric
- Pencil
- Ruler



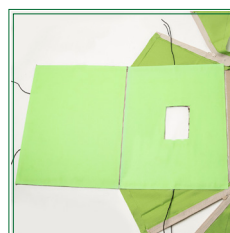
### DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut out a 3" x 2" rectangle in the middle of two sheets of green cardstock and two pieces of poster board.



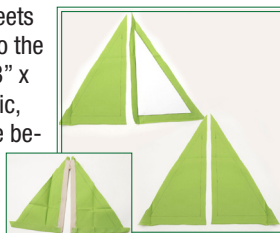
5. Fold the sheet of paper in half lengthwise. Place a piece of poster board over the folded sheet of paper, going from the corner to the side. Draw along the edge, and then cut out the triangle.



9. Glue the pieces of green cardstock over the poster boards.



2. Glue three sheets of poster board to the back side of a 13" x 28" piece of fabric, leaving ¼" space between the poster board pieces.



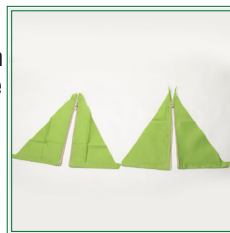
6. Using the paper triangle as a guide, cut out 4 triangles of fabric leaving ½" seam allowance on all sides.



10. Fold up the poster board sections into a tent shape. Glue the other side of the triangle/zipper sections to the poster board.



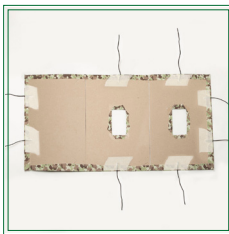
3. Fold over the edges of the fabric and glue. Snip through the fabric covering the rectangular openings, cutting both ways diagonally. Glue the flaps over the edges of the poster board.



7. Fold up ½" on the tall, straight side of all the triangles and glue the seams. Glue each zipper to two of the triangles along the seam you just made. Fold up and glue the bottom seam.



11. Cut out two 4" x 3" rectangles from the fabric. Fold over ½" and glue. Glue the middle part of two 5" cords to the top of the window. Glue the edge of one piece of fabric over it. Repeat for the other window.



4. Cut 8 pieces of cord 6" long. Tape and glue 2 pieces of cord to each of the short sides, then tape and glue pieces of cord to each of the long sides, even with the middle of the windows.



8. Glue the diagonal side of one of the triangle/zipper sections to the edge of the middle poster board section. Glue and tape two 6" pieces of cord to the middle of the poster board (see picture).



12. Set up the tent and tie the cords at the bottom. Open the zippers and tie up the openings to the tent. The tent is ready for camping and can be folded up for storage. Always be a happy camper!
