

KEY Connection



As it says in John 15:5, the key to bearing much fruit is to be constantly connected with Jesus. Making this keyholder is a fun way to remember that Jesus is the key!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Floral Wires
- Scissors
- Burlap
- Black Paint
- Metallic Antique Paint
- Masking Tape
- Buttons
- Fabric
- Metallic Gold Paint
- Diagonal Cutters
- Jute Twine
- Brushes
- Paper
- 3 Cardboard 11x8"
- Hot Glue Gun
- School Glue
- Sponge
- Black Marker



DIRECTIONS:

- 

1. Glue two pieces of the cardboard together. Fasten securely with masking tape. Make a hook from floral wire by bending a piece of wire in half, then making a bend near the ends. Repeat to make 3 more.
- 

2. Push the ends of the hooks through both sheets of cardboard, making a row along the bottom. On the back, bend the wires over like a paper fastener. Glue with hot glue.
- 

3. Fashion two loops from floral wire. Push the ends through the top corners of the third cardboard sheet to make the hangers that will hang on the wall. Fasten on the back with hot glue.
- 

4. Glue the cardboard with loops to the other cardboard, hooks and loops facing out. This is your panel. Glue burlap over the front and back.
- 

5. Make a rough drawing of a vine with a bunch of grapes.
- 

6. Glue jute twine on the panel as shown in the picture to make the vine. Wrap and glue jute twine around the hooks too.
- 

7. Glue several layers of buttons over the grape cluster.
- 

8. Draw some grape leaves on the fabric. Follow all the lines and veins with a raised bead of hot glue. Let dry.
- 

9. Mix school glue with some black paint. Paint over everything with this. Add a second coat if needed. Let dry.
- 

10. Dry-brush over all black surfaces with metallic gold paint. Do this several times as needed.
- 

11. Glue the grape cluster onto the panel. Dry-brush the grape cluster with metallic antique paint.
- 

12. Cut out the grape leaves and glue those on the vine. The key hanger is ready!
