

Stones last a long time because they are sturdy. Joshua 24:27 reminds that our promises to God should remain firm.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Wooden Board
- Rounded, Flat White Stones
- Small Light-colored Stones
- Dark-colored Stones
- Sandpaper
- Paint
- Paint Brush
- Sponge
- Light-colored Stain
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. If the stones have been collected outdoors, wash them in warm, soapy water. Let dry.



2. Sand the wooden board. Apply a light coat of stain. Let it dry. Sand it again lightly.



4. Hot glue the stones to the board, starting with the flower centers and petals. Glue the flower stems, and finish with the ground.



3. Arrange the stones on the board using large round stones for the flowers, small light-colored stones for the stem, and the dark stones for the ground.



5. Paint the middles of the flowers yellow and the stems green. This decorative board is ready to please your friends or be given as a gift to someone.
