





DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut a few strips of carboard the same height as the notebook. Glue them to the front cover of the notebook leaving a small gap between them. Press along the edges of the strips and make some lines in the top surface as well.









6. Paint the back cover of the note-book brown. Apply some black paint. Paint the inside edges of the back cover.



8. Apply some light-colored paint to the back cover, using a dry brush or sponge.



9. Apply paint to the front cover, using a dry brush or sponge. Glue the handle and the two strips to the door.



10. Apply paint with a dry brush or sponge to the inside edges of the cover.



and back pages of your notebook to the inside of the cover.



12. Decorate the door however you like from the modeling material. Your open-door notebook is ready!
