



Sometimes we can be as independent as owls. Paul pleaded with the Corinthians to be like-minded and work together (1 Peter 3:8). We, too, can work together as a team!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Aluminum Foil
- Paper Egg Cartons
- Manicure Scissors
- Tall, Round/Oval Glass Jar
- Newspaper
- Paint Brush
- School Glue
- Sponge
- Paint
- Brush for Glue
- 4 Large Googly Eyes
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Make a dome out of foil and glue it to the jar lid. Remove all stickers from the jar. Glue pieces of newspaper all over the outside of the jar and lid.



5. Cut out several rectangular shapes and cut a fringe along one edge of them. Hot glue them along the top of the jar in several rows.



9. Hot glue the entire surface of the head with fringe-edged strips. Cover the top of the head with small tear-drop-shaped pieces.



2. Make two owl feet from the egg carton and hot glue them to the bottom of the jar.



6. Hot glue one fringe strip all the way around the bottom of the lid. Screw the lid onto the jar.



10. Fill in any empty spaces with pieces from the egg carton. Check again to make sure that the lid can be screwed and unscrewed properly.



3. Cut teardrop shapes from the egg carton and hot glue them around the jar, starting at the bottom. The pieces should get smaller as you get closer to the top.



7. Cut out pieces to make the eye fringes, eyebrows and beak.



11. Carefully cut off the outer convex surface of two googly eyes. Apply yellow-green paint to the other two eyes. Glue on black pupils. Put the convex plastic in place over the top.



4. Cut out feather shapes to make the two wings. Fringe the edges. Hot glue them to the jar.



8. Hot glue the eye fringes, eyebrows and beak to the lid. Check to make sure the jar can be unscrewed easily.



12. Hot glue the eyes to the head. Apply color to the owl with a dry brush (sponge). This owl is able to turn its head!
