YOU WILL NEED:

- Brown Tape
- Green Tape
- Artificial Greenery
- 4 Washers ³/₈"
- Plastic Bucket

• 1 Carriage Bolt ⁵/₁₆"

Thick Stick

• Nut

- Black Marker
- 2 Zip Ties
- Scissors
- Card Board
- Ruler
- Hot Glue Gun <



DIRECTIONS:





1. Turn the bucket upside-down. Draw a hole about 21/4" in diameter about 2" from the closed end of the bucket. CAREFULLY cut out the hole.

2. Cut two sets of small holes on the opposite side of the bucket and thread two zip ties through them.



6. Decorate the surface of the

inside.





bucket as you wish. Underneath the 2" hole, CAREFULLY make a small 1/4" hole.

7. Thread the bolt through the small hole from the inside. Place the washer and nut over the bolt on the outside and tighten down well.

8. Fold a small piece of cardboard into a wedge. Cover it with green tape. Glue it well on the roof of the birdhouse. Secure it with tape too.

 Cover a 10x8" piece of cardboard with green tape, covering well on all sides. It will be a roof for the birdhouse.

10. Glue the roof on the top of the birdhouse. Secure it with tape too. Wrap green tape over the bolt several times.





11. Tape some artificial greenery to the birdhouse. Attach a thick stick to the birdhouse with the zip ties. Cut off excess.

12. Place the birdhouse on a tree or on a pole for our feathered friends to enjoy. If you wish, spray it with a water shield to make it last longer outside.




4. Seal the bucket using plenty of tape so it adheres well.
