



Looking at God's rainbow reminds us of His promise that, even when we make mistakes, He can give us a new beginning (Genesis 9:16).

### YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 Large Wooden Bead
- White Clothesline
- Purple Yarn
- Dark Blue (Indigo) Yarn
- Blue Yarn
- Green Yarn
- Yellow Yarn
- Orange Yarn
- Red Yarn
- Ruler
- Floral Wire
- String
- Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun
- Wire Cutters



### DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut off a 10" piece of clothesline. Cut a 6" piece of floral wire.



2. Place a drop of hot glue 2" from the end of the piece of clothesline and glue one end of the wire there.



3. Wrap the clothesline and the wire together with purple yarn in an even layer, leaving 2" of clothesline free on each end.



4. Bend the wrapped clothesline into an arch.



5. Lay more clothesline over the top of the arch, matching up the ends. Cut. Measure the length of this piece of cord and cut a piece of wire 4" shorter than it.



6. Repeat steps 2 and 3 using the dark blue yarn. Bend it into an arch and glue it above the purple one.



7. Repeat steps 5, 2, 3, & 4 for each of the remaining colors: light blue, green, yellow, orange, and red. Before gluing the red arch, knot a 12-14" piece of string in the middle of it.



8. Hot glue the red arch in place. Thread both ends of the string into the hole on the bead. Tie a few knots and make a loop.



9. Unravel the ends of the clothesline.



10. The colorful rainbow will remind you of God's promises.
