1. Paint two jumbo craft sticks.


Rubber Bands

5. Stick lid on one end of wooden skewer. Repeat with other skewer. Hot glue skewers to the inside of the lid.

9. Attach the other end of the rubber band to the rear axle. Add a drop of hot glue.




2. Place the two sticks on a flat surface. colored side down, in the shape of a "V". Place a 1" piece of skewer on top of the sticks at the pointed end, letting the tip jut out 1/4" and hot glue in place very well.



3. Flip the craft sticks over. Hot glue a 2 1/2" piece of straw to the narrow end. Hot glue two 1" straws to the other ends, making sure they face parallel to each other.

4. Pierce a hole in the center of four plastic lids.



6. Insert skewer end through straws. Put remaining two caps on ends of skewers.
