

Isaiah 41:9 tells us that God takes care of His servants. Because of Rahab's faith, she not only helped save her people with the red chord, but those who would capture Jericho. Later, Rahab became a great-grandmother of Jesus, reminding us of the saving blood of Jesus.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Paperclips
- Pink Ribbon
- Red Ribbon
- Tacky Glue
- Scissors
- Ruler



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut four pieces of ribbon 9" - 10" long, 2 red and 2 pink.



5. Weave the four ribbons into a heart shape as shown in the picture. You can begin to see what the finished heart will look like.



9. Weave a small heart at the end of the red ribbon using the pink ribbon.



2. Glue the matching ribbons together at the ends and let dry.



6. Carefully pull out the top ribbons. Fold the bottom ends of the ribbons under. Trim and glue. Let dry.

7. Re-thread the top



10. Glue the small heart and let dry. You can use paper clips to hold the ribbons in place until the glue dries.



3. Glue the ends of the ribbon together at a 90 degree angle. Let dry.



ribbons, weaving them in a checkerboard pattern. Fasten the ends of the top ribbons to the back side, cutting off the excess. Let dry. You can use paper clips to keep the ribbons in place until the glue dries.



11. Fold the red ribbon with the little heart on it as shown in the picture. Glue the big heart onto the fold of the small heart ribbon. The free end of the ribbon should be on top. Let dry.



4. Trim off the protruding part of the pink ribbon. Lift the top red ribbon and turn it to the back so the red ribbons are inside-out. Glue and let dry.



8. Cut a piece about 25" long of red ribbon and another piece about 6" from pink ribbon.



12. Use the heart bookmark for your Bible. It can mark two places in the Bible at the same time. Enjoy!
