

Sometimes it's hard to have peace in our home, especially when tension grows, as it did with Isaac and Ishmael. Will you create peace in your family, as it says in Isaiah 32:17-18?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Braided Rope
- School Glue
- Floral Wire
- Brush
- Marker
- Tape
- Paper
- Hot Glue Gun
- Diagonal Cutters
- Waxed Paper
 Electrical Tape
 Craft Knife



DIRECTIONS:



1. Hot glue the end of the floral wire to the tip of the rope. Wrap the end well with electrical tape.



2. Wrap the wire around the rope in a spiral, securing with hot glue as needed.



3. Tape two sheets of paper together lengthwise. Write the word "peace" in cursive without lifting the marker. The word should be approximately 18x3".



4. Wind the rope over the pattern, hot gluing over all the places the rope overlaps itself.



5. Place a dot of hot glue in several places to secure the rope to the paper.



6. Cut off the end of the rope and wire. Hot glue and tape as before.



7. Carefully peel the rope from the paper. Place on a sheet of waxed paper.



8. Paint over the rope with school glue. Let dry.



9. Peel the rope from the waxed paper and turn over. Apply glue to the other side and let dry.



10. Paint the rope with any color of acrylic paint if you like. Your rope is ready to remind you to create peace.
