



Soaring to the Heavens

When we look at the stars and the sky, we can see God's handiwork in all of its glory (Psalm 19:1). Make this kite to remind you of the beauty and glory of His creation.

YOU WILL NEED:

- 3/16" x 36" Wooden Dowel
- 3/8" x 6" Wooden Dowel
- Colored Plastic Table Covers
- Strong Thin String (Kite String)
- Craft Knife
- School Glue
- Yarn
- Tape
- Scissors



DIRECTIONS:

	<p>1. Cut off 13" from the 36" dowel. Attach the short dowel piece perpendicular to the long piece at a point 6" or 7" below the tip using string.</p>		<p>5. Fold the edge over the string and tape in place.</p>		<p>9. Attach the end of the 30' yarn to the kite where the dowels cross. Tie it to the middle of the 15" yarn also. Put a drop of glue on all knots.</p>
	<p>2. Put a drop of school glue on the knot.</p>		<p>6. Wind string around the dowel ends and put a drop of glue over all the knots.</p>		<p>10. For the decorations, cut some small strips of plastic.</p>
	<p>3. Cut a small notch at each end of the dowels. Wind the string around the dowel ends and connect the ends together to make a diamond shape. Put a drop of school glue on the knots.</p>		<p>7. Wind about 30' of yarn around the 6" dowel.</p>		<p>11. Tie strips into bundles and tie them onto some lengths of kite string. Put glue on the knots.</p>
	<p>4. Cut a diamond-shaped piece from the plastic tablecloth the size of the string outline, adding a 1" border all the way around.</p>		<p>8. Tie a 15" piece of yarn to the ends of the cross piece of the kite. Put a drop of school glue on the knots.</p>		<p>12. Tie the tasseled strings to the bottom and side pieces of the kite and glue on some stars. Enjoy!</p>
