- Cardboard
- Poster Board
- Masking Tape
- Paper Napkins
- Lace, Ricrac, Cord

DIRECTIONS:

2 Brad Fasteners • 2 Key Rings

- 2 Small Hinges
- Split Peas
- Compass
- Scissors Ruler
- Brushes
- Sponge • 1 Hasp
- Pencil
- Paint
- School Glue
- Craft Knife 🔇
- Hot Glue Gun 🔇






1. From cardboard, cut out 4 - 8x4" rectangles. These will be used for the front and back Cut out 4 - 5x4" rectangles for the sides, and 2 - 5x71/4" rectangles for the bottom.







2. Glue two rectangles of the same size together to make one rectangle. Repeat for all the pieces. Fit the pieces together to make a box and glue.



making the diameter the the box. Cut the circles out and cut them in half. Glue each set of two semicircles into one. 4. Measure the outside


edge of the semicircle. Cut a rectangle from cardboard using this measurement for the length and 71/4" for the width. The corrugations should go from side to side. Glue the sides of the cardboard to the round edge of the semicircles.



5. The area of the lid and the box must match. If not, glue a few sheets of cardboard to the box to make up the difference. Cover all edges with masking tape.







8. Paint the inside of the box and lid red and the entire outside black. Let it dry.










12. Hot glue decorative hasp on the front of the chest. Now you have a chest to hold all your little treasures.
