




UNTOUCHABLE Snow Leopard

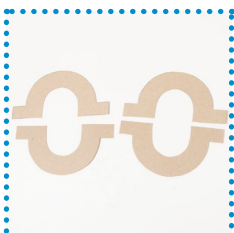
Like being afraid to touch the leopard, the people in the Bible were afraid and forbidden to touch a leper. Jesus showed compassion to those in trouble and asks us to comfort others (2 Corinthians 1:3-4).

YOU WILL NEED:

- Black Yarn
- White Yarn
- Scissors
- Poster Board
- Compass
- White Felt
- Blue Felt
- Black Felt
- 2 Binder Clips
- Compass
- Pencil
- Paper
- Ruler
- Hot Glue Gun 



DIRECTIONS:



1. Using poster board, cut out four of the 3" high semicircles with tabs. (See pattern in attachment).



2. Place two semicircles on top of each other. Wrap 1-3 layers of white yarn evenly around them. Wind black yarn 1-4 times around the semicircle in 5 separate places.



3. Wrap another 2-4 layers of white yarn evenly around the semicircle. Continue wrapping alternating layers of white and black yarn.



4. Wrap the other two semicircles in the same way, with the same amount of yarn.



5. Bend the tabs up and attach together with binder clips.



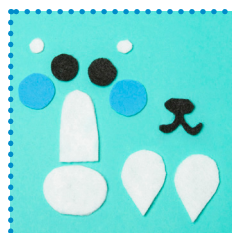
6. Carefully cut the yarn between the circles of poster board.



7. Work a piece of white yarn between circles and knot tightly around the strands of yarn; then knot again on the other side. Repeat, ending with a double knot.



8. Remove the poster board and trim any yarn ends that are sticking out, until you have a nice smooth ball.



9. Cut two eyes out of blue felt. From white felt, cut out two ears, two pieces for the muzzle and two eye highlights. From black, cut out nose, mouth, and two pupils for the eyes. (See pattern in attachment).



10. Glue the eyes, muzzle, nose, mouth and ears to the snow leopard's head.



11. Make some white pom-poms in different sizes.



12. Have fun tossing your snow leopard and snowballs!
