## YOU WILL NEED:

- Black Yarn
- White Yarn
- Scissors
- Poster Board
- Compass
- White Felt
- Blue Felt
- Black Felt
- 2 Binder Clips
- Compass
- Pencil
- Paper
- Ruler
- Hot Glue Gun



## **DIRECTIONS:**



1. Using poster board, cut out four of the 3" high semicircles with tabs. (See pattern in attachment).



2. Place two semicircles on top of each other. Wrap 1-3 layers of white varn evenly around them. Wind black yarn 1-4 times around the semicircle in 5 separate places.



3. Wrap another 2-4 layers of white yarn evenly around the semicircle. Continue wrapping alternating lavers of white and black yarn.



4. Wrap the other two semicircles in the same way, with the same amount of yarn.



6. Carefully cut the yarn between the circles of poster

8. Remove the poster board and trim any yarn ends that are sticking out, until you have a nice smooth ball.
