



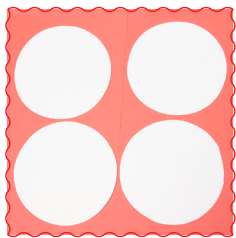
The Holy Spirit is likened to a dove, coming down to grant us God's power. Jesus calls us to be His witnesses in every part of the world (Acts 1:8).

### YOU WILL NEED:

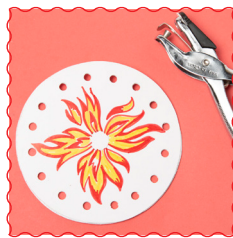
- Red and Yellow Markers
- Thin (non-corrugated) White Cardboard
- Thin, Unbreakable Cord
- 2 Key Rings
- 2 Large Buttons
- 2 Toothpicks
- Glue Stick
- Pencil
- CD
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Hole Puncher
- Hot Glue Gun
- Craft Knife



### DIRECTIONS:



1. Trace around the CD on the thin white cardboard. Make 3-4 circles and cut them out.



5. Punch holes all around the edge of the disc with a hole punch. If the circle is too thick to punch easily, ask an adult for help.



9. To spin, hold a ring in each hand. Place the disc in the middle of the cord. Rotate the disc like you are turning a jump-rope for 50-60 rotations.



2. Glue all the circles on top of one another to make 1 disc.



6. With a knife, cut out a square in the center of the disc. The square should be smaller than the buttons. Hot glue a button in the exact center of the disc, without glue in the button holes.



10. Pull gently on the rings. The disc will begin to rotate in one direction.



3. On one side of the disc, use markers to draw flames coming out from the center.



7. Turn the disc over. Insert two toothpicks into button holes that are opposite each other. Hot glue the second button over the first one so that the holes line up.



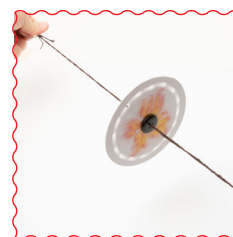
11. Slightly loosen the tension of the cords and the disc will begin to rotate in the opposite direction.



4. On the other side of the disc, use markers to draw flames along the edge of it. Place the CD on the disc and trace around the small hole in the middle.



8. Cut about 50" of cord. Pass the cord through the two opposite holes in the buttons. Tie the ends of the cord together. Tie rings to both ends. Your hand spinner is ready.



12. Alternate the tension on the cords by tightening and loosening. It will feel like you are stretching and loosening a rubber band. As the disk spins quickly, the holes in it will make a sound like the wind. Remember how the Holy Spirit came with a mighty, rushing wind (Acts 2:2)?
