

## **JELLYFISH**

## **SUPPLIES:**

- Clear plastic bowl (48 ounces)
- Plain transparent shower cap
- Fishing wire
- Lots of pieces for dangling (ribbons, shiny fabric, pom poms, bubble wrap, cellophane, etc.)
- Metal skewer



- Scissors
- Toothpick
- Ribbon for tying all dangling pieces together

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. With a parent's help, heat the tip of the metal skewer over a stovetop or open flame - be careful, it will be hot! Poke a hole in the middle of the plastic bowl.
- 2. Place the shower cap over the bottom side of the bowl.
- 3. Make a hole in the shower cap to match the hole in the bowl.
- 4. Cut lengths of fabrics and ribbon, mixing textures and lengths for the jellyfish tentacles.
- 5. Line up all of the cut fabrics and streamers on your table, then bunch them in the middle and tie with ribbon. Leave some length to the ribbon so it can be another tentacle. Use scissors to curl the ribbon if you like.
- 6. Take the fishing wire and loop it around the bundle, then thread the fishing wire through the hole in your bowl and shower cap.
- 7. Pull the fishing wire through, tie it off, and hang your jellyfish.
- 8. To make it light up, you can also add battery operated fairy lights!

**Enjoy watching this creation drift** in the air, and remember God's canopy of safety when we obey Him!
