

## **WAVE PAINTING**

## **SUPPLIES:**

- Canvas board of any size
- Acrylic paints: white, yellow, and 4 shades of blue
- Wide bristle paintbrush
- Small-tipped paintbrush
- Toothbrush
- Paper plate
- Paper towel
- Small amount of water to thin paint

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Take your wide-tip paintbrush and paint a coat of light blue over the entire canvas.
- 2. Dip your wide-tip paintbrush in a darker blue and dot the top ½ to ¾ of your canvas. Draw your brush across the blue dots to create the sky.
- 3. Take your white paint and make the shape of the inside of a wave.
- 4. Take a light shade of blue and make a line of paint on the outside of the wave shape.
- 5. Take a medium shade of blue and make another line of paint on the outside of the light blue line.
- 6. Take the yellow paint and make a line of paint on the outside of the medium blue.
- 7. Take the darkest shade of blue and make a dotted line on the outside of the medium blue line.
- 8. Take your toothbrush and follow the curve of the waves, slowly blending your wave lines, but leaving some contrast. You can make your wave as high as you want.
- 9. Dip your finger in the white paint and dab it on the top ridge of the wave to form the foam
- Take your fine-tip paintbrush, and spatter some thinned-down white paint onto the waves to make flecks of foam on your wave.

This beautiful creation will remind you that nature obeys Jesus' command:

"Peace, be still!"
