




FRAMED SHELL ANGEL

SCRIPTURE
Acts 27:23-24

SUPPLIES:

- White 8" x 10" picture frame
- Black card stock
- 2 cockle or clam shells (wings)
- 1 smaller cockle or clamshell (head)
- 1 larger shell (body)
- Shells for frame decoration
- Silver Sharpie and/or glitter glue pen
- Hot glue gun 
- Hot glue sticks

DIRECTIONS:

1. Open the frame, remove the glass, and turn the frame face down.
2. Cut the black cardstock to fit the picture frame, place it in the frame, and replace the frame backing.
3. Flip your frame face up, making sure your frame's stand is in the correct orientation to allow you to display your art right-side up.
4. Take your largest shell (body) and place it in the center of the black cardstock.
5. Place your two wing shells on either side of the body shell, and your smallest shell (head) on the top of the body. Apply hot glue to the outside edges of your shells and glue to the cardstock.
6. With your silver Sharpie, draw a halo over the head of your angel. Outline the halo with glitter glue if desired.
7. Glue decorative shells to the four corners of your picture frame.

Remember that God sends His angels when we are in the storms of life, just like He did for Paul when he was stuck on the ship in the middle of stormy seas!
