

## FRAMED DOVE WITH HANDPRINT WING

## **SUPPLIES:**

- White and blue cardstock
- Dove template
- 8" x 10" picture frame
- Pencil
- Acrylic paints: green, white, and orange
- Wide bristle paintbrush
- Fine-tip paintbrush
- Black Sharpie marker
- Glue stick
- Paper plate for paint
- Scissors

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Print out the template and trace your dove from white cardstock.
- 2. Cut out the dove, without wings.
- 3. Use the glue stick to glue the dove onto the blue cardstock slightly below the middle of the paper (paper should be in portrait orientation).
- 4. Using the Sharpie, make a dot on the dove's head for its eye.
- 5. On the bottom of the page, write, "It is time..." Genesis 8:16
- 6. Squeeze out a small amount of orange, green, and a slightly larger amount of white paint onto your plate.
- 7. Using your fine-tip paintbrush, paint an orange beak on your dove.
- 8. Using your fine-tip paintbrush, paint a green olive stem and leaves in the dove's beak.
- 9. Dip your wide bristle paintbrush in the white paint and apply a generous amount of paint to the palm of your opposite hand.
- Stamp your hand above your dove (the bottom edge of your palm should touch the top of the dove's back). Allow to dry.
- 11. Insert your artwork into your picture frame and enjoy!

Remember, we need to wait patiently on the Lord just as Noah did on the ark. It was God's perfect timing for Noah and his family to leave the ark.
