

## FOIL PAINTED ALTAR AND RAM

## **SUPPLIES:**

- Cardstock in grey, brown, and black
- Two squares of aluminum foil (6" x 6")
- Acrylic paints in red, orange, and white
- Plate for paint
- Glue stick
- Small rocks
- Hot glue gun 💔
- Hot glue sticks
- Small googly eyes
- Scissors

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Squeeze out yellow, red, and white paint on your plate.
- 2. Place your sheet of grey cardstock in front of you, landscape orientation (this will be your background).
- 3. Cut two rectangles (about 6" x 1") to use as the wood pieces for the altar fire.
- 4. Use the glue stick to glue them in a diagonal cross (like a squished "X") toward the bottom of the paper on the left side, leaving about an inch of space.
- 5. Use hot glue to glue the small rocks below the wood pieces to create an altar (use a dot of hot glue on the paper for each rock).
- 6. Crunch up a square of aluminum foil and dip it in the red paint. Stamp the paint above the wood on the altar to look like fire.
- 7. Using the same piece of foil, dip it into the orange paint and stamp the paint in with the orange to make the flames.
- 8. Crunch up the second foil piece into a ball and dip it in the white paint. Stamp the space on the right side of the paper to make the body of the ram.
- 9. Cut a ram's head and two front legs out of the black card stock. Glue the ram's head in the center of the body, and the two legs toward the bottom.
- 10. Glue on the googly eyes.

This is a reminder of the story in Genesis 22, where Abraham was asked by God to sacrifice his son, Isaac. God will test our characters, too! Will we do what we are asked?
