

PAPER STRAW HEART

SUPPLIES:

- 27 paper straws
- Duct tape
- Ribbon for hanging craft
- Hot glue gun 💔
- Hot glue sticks
- Colored paper (one sheet)
- Pencil
- Scissors

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Arrange 25 straws horizontally. Even up the edges with your two extra straws, then set those straws aside (you will not use them again).
- 2. Place a strip of duct tape on each outside edge of your straws, then place a strip of tape on the center. Smooth the tape to the straws to make sure it sticks.
- 3. Put a dot of hot glue on one upper corner of your straw bundle and press one end of your ribbon to it. Repeat on the other side with the other end of the ribbon. Turn your straws over, and fold over any tape ends. This is the front of your picture.
- 4. Place your heart template in the center of your piece of colored paper and trace the heart with your pencil.
- 5. Take your pencil and carefully poke a hole in the center of your heart tracing to create a hole to use your scissors to cut out the heart. Discard the center of your heart and use the heart frame.
- 6. Place the heart frame on your straws. Lift each corner, one at a time, and use hot glue to stick it down. Add a dab of hot glue at the peak of the heart to stick that down, too.

Each time you look at your colorful heart, remember that Jesus transforms our hearts just as He was transformed on a mountain.
